SEAFA will, initially, take the decision from Minister Essop to give environmental approval for the project on review in the High Court. SEAFA will also engage the City and Province to ensure that Erven 151, 153 and 318 not be rezoned.

Preliminary indications from our legal team are that we have good prospects of being successful.
